The first play in English theatre to portray a Jewish character as the hero, Richard Cumberland's *The Jew*, debuted to American audiences in Philadelphia in 1830. In the early 1900's Philadelphia was a vibrant center of Yiddish theatre, with all the greats of that era glittering on the marquees of its theatres. **But, with the diminishing light of Yiddish theatre, Jewish theatre lay dormant in Philadelphia -- until the birth of Theatre Ariel in 1990.**

34 years ago Deborah Baer Mozes founded Theatre Ariel to address this gap in our city's cultural mosaic. Since then, **Theatre Ariel has offered a deep and ongoing interaction with Jewish history, thought and culture** to Philadelphia audiences. Theatre Ariel shows serve as a shared space where everyone, regardless of background, style of worship, or type of belief can come together and experience powerful, meaningful stories. We believe that **by shining a light on the specific, we illuminate the universal.**
